Sheldon Edward Dixon (known as Bill Dixon) passed away in Jonestown Texas on June 29th, 2022, at the age of 81. Bill was born in San Francisco California on January 4th, 1941. He lived in Yosemite California by the Tuolumne River as a child. He attended Jefferson High school in San Francisco California in 1955.
