David Bernard Beckman, longtime resident of Ft. Worth, Texas passed away at his home in Dripping Springs, Texas on Saturday, December 15, 2012 after a long battle with Muscular Dystrophy.

After graduating from Amon Carter Riverside High School, David joined the US Army where he was stationed in Germany. Upon returning stateside, he attended Texas Christian University in Ft. Worth.

Throughout his life, he was a real estate broker, builder and owner/operator of Beckman Transport. In addition, he was a qualified commercial pilot for single and multi-engine airplanes and was an instrument rated pilot.

To prevent his mother from entering a nursing home, David, with the financial help of his brother, Phil, sacrificed his business interests to provide 24 hour personal care for his mother until her death - evidence of his compassion and caring nature.
