*She loved her family, friends, and a good laugh. Who could ask for more?*

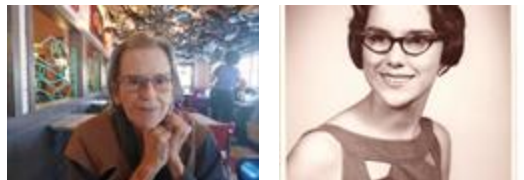
