



## George William Prewitt

October 4, 1939 - August 8, 2025

George William Prewitt, aged 85, passed from this earth into the arms of his heavenly Father on August 8, 2025.

George was born in a rural farmhouse in Southwest Bell County off of Briggs Road on October 4, 1939, near the Iduma Community south of Killeen to John Henry Prewitt and Mary Gore-Prewitt. He graduated from Killeen High School in 1957. After high school, he joined the U.S. Air Force where he served for four years. He married the love of his life Louise Johnson of Augusta, Georgia on August 1, 1960.

He enjoyed a lengthy career as a civil servant with the Fort Hood Fire Department and was graced with the opportunity to retire at the early age of fifty. A devout Christian, he served as a deacon at Memorial Baptist Church for 41 years, taught Sunday School classes, was director of Children's Church Ministries, and also a bus driver for the bus ministry for 23 years. In his spare time, he also made three mission trips to Mexico.

He is survived by his beloved wife, Louise, to whom he was married for 65 years, daughter Nyla Kirby and husband Richard of Killeen, son Farrell Prewitt and wife Patricia of Burnet, and three grandchildren Georgeanne, Nathan, and Frances.
