Jack Emmett Cole, 84, of Austin, Texas, passed away Friday, October 31st, 2014. He was born in Birmingham, Alabama, on May 8, 1930 to Robert Cliff and Claudia Mae Cole. He served as an Officer in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict, and commanded the Birmingham Alabama Post of the National Guard. Among his many medals was the Silver Star.
