A celebration of Michael's life will be announced to be held on Lake Travis, Texas, honoring the man who gave so much to those around him.

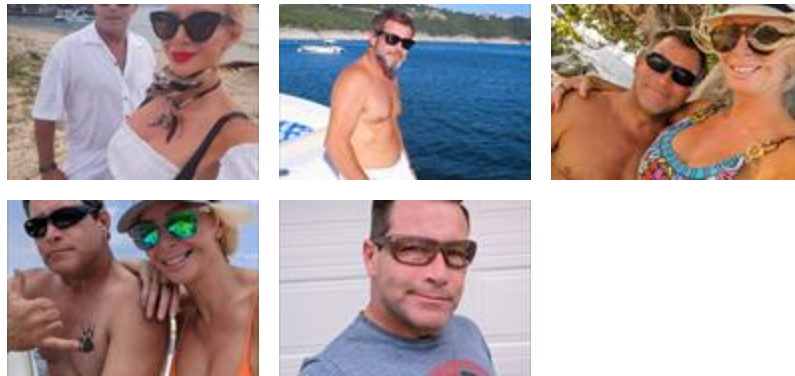

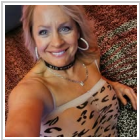

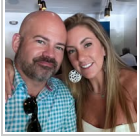
