Milton was the middle child of nine children of Milton and Josephine(Rihn) Lutz, he attended Saint Anne's Elementary School and was a graduate of Central Catholic High School, San Antonio, Texas. Following graduation he entered Saint Mary's University for 2 years later he joined the United States Army and spent a few years in Germany upon completion of his military service he returned to Saint Mary's University to complete his education and get his degree in Math and Science.
