Ollie June Herod Moore went to be with her Lord on June 18, 2020 after a decline in health over the past month or so following her 80th birthday.

She was born on June 13, 1940 to Audie Herod and Ruby Riley in Breckenridge, Texas. She graduated from Throckmorton High School on May 23, 1958.
