Dick was born on May 30, 1929 in San Antonio, TX to Richard Louis and Mildred Elise Seeberg Goeth. He died on January 27, 2017 in Austin, TX. During the war years of WWII, Dick attended schools in San Antonio, TX, Rantoul, IL, Wichita Falls, TX, and Pompano Beach, FL prior to graduating from Austin High School in 1946. He completed the NROTC program and received a BS degree in Mechanical Engineering at the University of Texas in Austin.

Dick held managerial positions at the Radio Corporation of America (RCA), American Standard Industrial Division, Milstead Supply of Austin, Climate Engineering of Austin, and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT). Dick was a commissioned officer in the United States Naval Reserve, Civil Engineer Corps, and served on active duty at the US Naval Air Station, Subic Bay, Philippine Islands.

In 1954, Dick married Elisabeth Field and moved to Detroit and then Dallas where their three daughters were born, and where they lived until 1969, when they returned to Austin.

Dick is survived by his wife Elisabeth, his children and their families: Elise and Rick Schram, Marshall and Caroline Schram, Caroline and Cody Holden, and Catherine Schram, Loraine and Barry Wood, Katlin Wood, Cara Wood and Hope Wood, Beverly and Bruce Irick, Bennett and Kayla Irick, and Brandon Irick and his twin brother, Rolf Goeth of Las Vegas, Nevada.
