Sarah J Pasch passed peacefully in Austin, TX at the age of 85 on July 12, 2023. She was born to N. which she suffered with in recent years, and then a serious stroke early this year, finally agreeing to leave her beloved home in Chicago and come back to Texas to be close to her daughters and their families. She was a firm believer that we each create our own reality and whatever happens in our lives is to serve our purpose here. She may have felt that she had accomplished what she came here to do, but for the rest of us it was too soon and we miss her terribly.

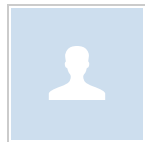

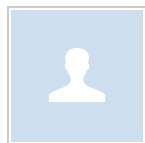
