The memorial service for Steve Hall, 64 of Holland will be held at Vista Community Church in Temple at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 24.

Steven Leon Hall was born on September 8, 1958 in Mexia, Texas to Leroy Vickrey and Nelda Raye Rudasill. After a valiant 14-month battle with pancreatic cancer, Steve passed away on Tuesday, June 13, in the company of his wife and children. Anyone who knew him knew that his greatest joy came from his ever-growing family. He is survived by his wife, Janell (Weems); son Brian Hall and wife Victoria King of Farmers Branch; daughter Sarah Galle of Temple; daughter Molly Ledadom and husband Sam of Ridgecrest, California; and his 4 grandchildren: Logan Ledadom, Kayla and Mattis Ledadom, and Luca King-Hall. He is survived by his brother Rick Vickrey and wife Janet of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee; brother Mike Hall and wife Kelly of Carrollton; and brother David Hall and sister Raye Lynn Hall of Bowie. Steve graduated Summa cum Laude in 1976 from Brewer High School in White Settlement and continued his education through Texas State Technical Institute in Waco. He married the love of his life on June 5, 1982 and they began their family in 1985. Steve, Janell, and their kids moved to Diamond Bar, California in 1989 to follow Steve's job. They raised their family in California until their children were grown, at which point they moved back to Bell County to slow down and enjoy the next stage of their lives as Pop Pop

and Mimi.

While he belonged to several different church congregations throughout his life, Steve found his purpose through serving the church in foreign missions in Mexico and Guatemala. His passion for service grew with every construction and outreach trip he served on. His quiet faith and leadership were an inspiration to many.

From the time he graduated from TSTI, Steve worked in the commercial lighting industry in various capacities, where he was loved and respected by all who knew him.
