Susan Marie Feltz, 51, of Copperas Cove, Texas passed away from ovarian cancer on March 3, 2023.

Susan was born on November 3, 1971, and grew up in Salem, New Hampshire. As a teen she was involved in many activities at Mary Queen of Peace Church, she received her Gold Award in Girl Scouts, and was a member of the SHS color guard. She graduated Salem High school in 1990. She knew her calling was in service of others early in life. In her early adult years, she was Director of Marking for Statesboro Mall in Georgia before moving back to New Hampshire where she was an LNA at the Northeast Rehabilitation Hospital. Life took her to Germany where she worked for the Department of Defense of Education. There she was a fierce advocate for individuals with special needs and began teaching as a paraprofessional. After five years abroad, she moved to Texas where she started her career with Central Counties Services assisting individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

She received two master's degrees, one in Applied Behavior Analysis and another in Counseling. She obtained her License as a Professional Counselor and became Board Certified in Behavior Analysis. Her talent and skill in the field of applied behavior analysis and counseling was immeasurable and was an integral part of the Central Counties Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Behavior support and crisis team. Susan had a knack for reaching families who no one else could through her sense of humor and

assertiveness.

Susan was witty, open minded, and loved to connect with people. She had eclectic tastes in music, cultures, and religions. She was a Reiki Master, essential oil connoisseur, tarot reader, natural stone collector, and medium. Many sought her help and services as an intuitive counselor. She worked with law enforcement to find missing persons and was always reaching out to anyone in need. She loved her family and friends fiercely.

Susan is survived by her two daughters, Jasa Marie Harris and Logan Olivia Harris (Cade Campbell), two grandchildren, Alaois and Aria, her mother, Rosalind L. Livingston, her siblings, Dr. Katie B. Paré (Justin), Daniel F. Livingston, Jr. (Sue) and Stephen F. Livingston. Susan was preceded in death by her father Daniel F. Livingston Sr., and her brother Scott C. Livingston.
