Theresa Strojek, age 63, of Marble Falls, Texas passed away on April 7, 2024.

She was born in San Juan County, New Mexico to John Joseph Strojek and Rosemary Theresa Mrak on March 6, 1961. Theresa attended school in Ector County, Texas, and graduated from Permian High School. She then attended and graduated from Tarleton State University with a Bachelor of Business Administration degree with honors.

She returned to Odessa, Texas, and entered the banking industry and later became an employee of Resolution Trust Company, an agency of the federal government. After several years, Theresa made the decision to live in San Antonio, Texas. Her employment with Aetna Health Insurance began in August, 1995 in their claims department, becoming a claim analyst and then a special project analyst. CVS Health acquired Aetna and became her new employer, remaining so until March 28, 2024.

After losing her mom to cancer in 1970, her father married Peggy Bosse Doran on July 3, 1976. In short order, a close and lifelong relationship formed between these two.
