Thomas Cecil Hyde III, better known as TC, son of Thomas and Sharon Hyde, was born on December 20, 1977 in Austin, Texas and like his father before him, was a true Texan and an Austinite in heart and soul.

TC was full of life and vigor and had a charm that made people feel good to be in his company. He was witty and bright and he loved to laugh and enjoy the moment. He was an intelligent Sagittarian who relished learning everything he could about and from the people around him, and his sincere interest in people endeared him to so many. There are no words to fully convey how much TC will be missed, but the lives of those who knew and loved him will never be the same.

TC died on January 22, 2015 in a traffic accident. He is survived by his parents, Tom and Sherri Hyde, his sister Sabrina, his brother David, his fiancée, Collette and her son, Tyler as well as a large family of aunts, uncles, great aunts, great uncles, nieces, nephews and many cousins.
