William Walter Boroski went to be with our Lord and Savior on July 18, 2023. Willy was born in Wurzburg, Germany on August 18, 1959 to Anton Walter and Lois Mae Boroski. His dad being a Captain in the army was later stationed at what was then known as Fort Hood and the family settled in Copperas Cove, Texas. Willy was an athlete, actor and class clown during his growing years. His love for acting only grew in Summer stock theater in Findlay, OH. After high school he spent time in Germany and California. He received his Bachelor's degree at the College of the Ozarks and then pursued his successful career in acting, singing, directing and producing. He later studied at Texas Woman's University where he met his bride-to-be, Teresa Griffith. They were married 28 years and lived in several places, but finally settled in Georgetown, TX. No greater love on earth did Willy ever know than that he shared with his wife Teresa and his son Jamen.

Willy was always known for his amazing voice and will always be remembered as the writer of "A Tribute to Marty Robbins" which his singing duo, Willy and the Cowboy charted the song at #23; on stages from the Palomino in Los Angeles to the Grand Ole Opry in Nashville, TN. He directed George C. Scott and Martin Sheen at the Savoy theater in Santa Barbara, California. Willy had many achievements in his life and always enjoyed helping others. He was an acting coach, writer, mentor and friend to many. He could always tell a good story and often touched the hearts of others. Above all he loved the Lord and

those who knew him, know that he is singing with the angels.

He is preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Suzanne Pollard. He is survived by his wife, Teresa and son Jamen, and lovely sisters. Peggy Smith, Judi Herrera and Debbie Iwuagwu. He also loved his brother-in-laws, three nieces and several nephews. He was a former member of New Hope Baptist Church in Krugerville, TX and First Baptist Church of Round Rock, TX
